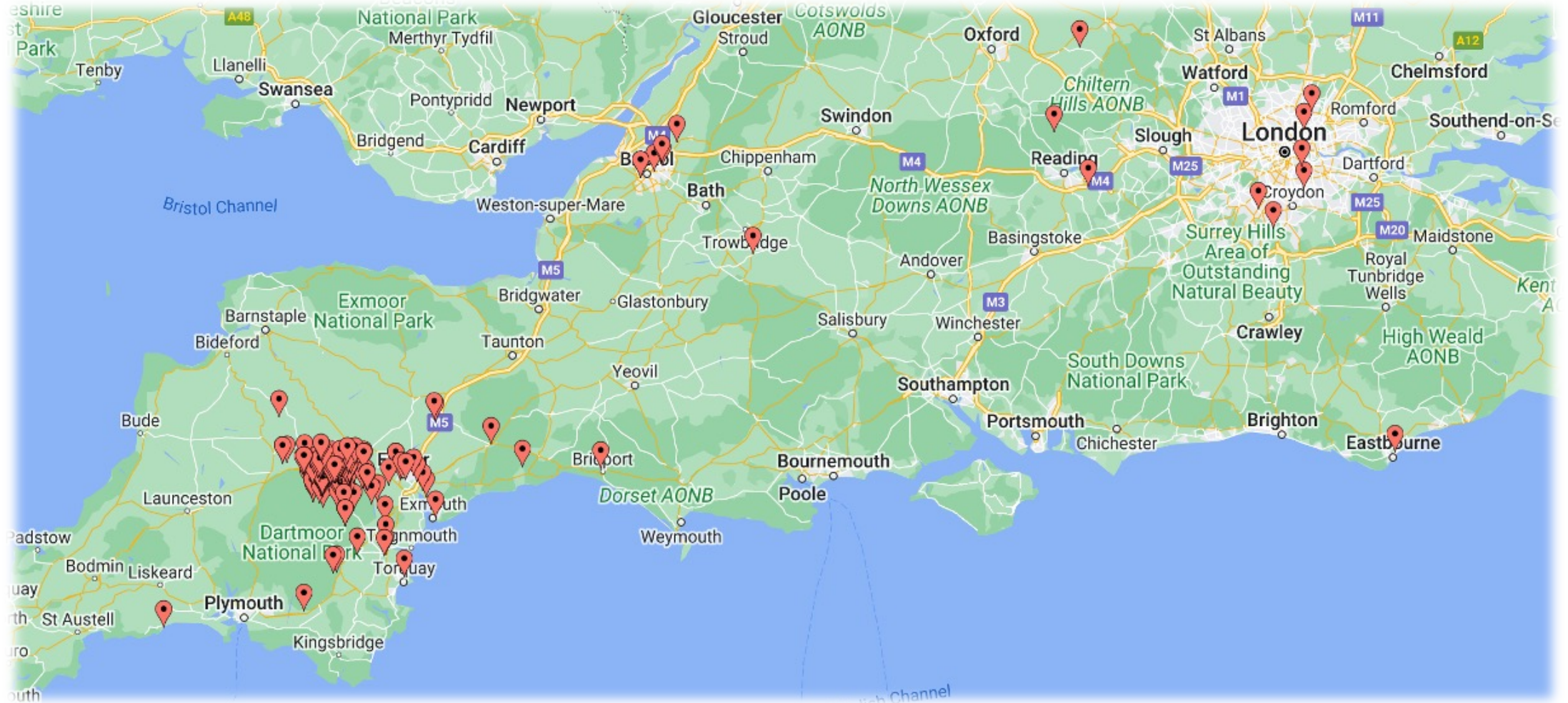

Survey respondents by postcode

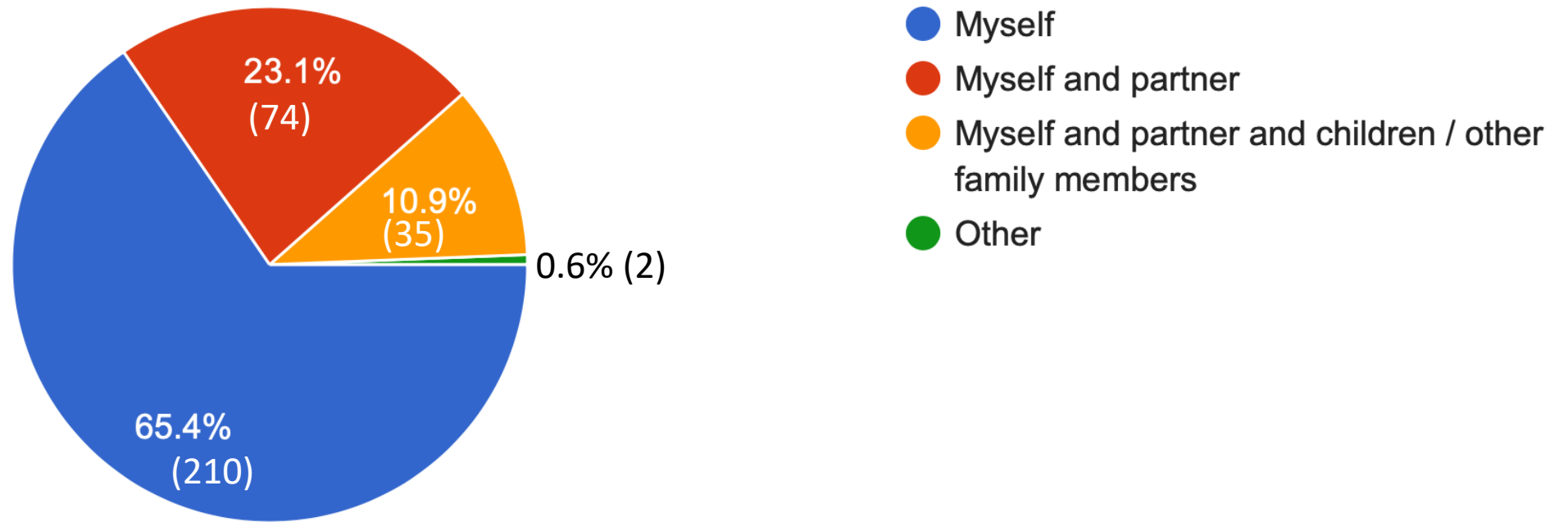


Survey respondents by postcode (more local)

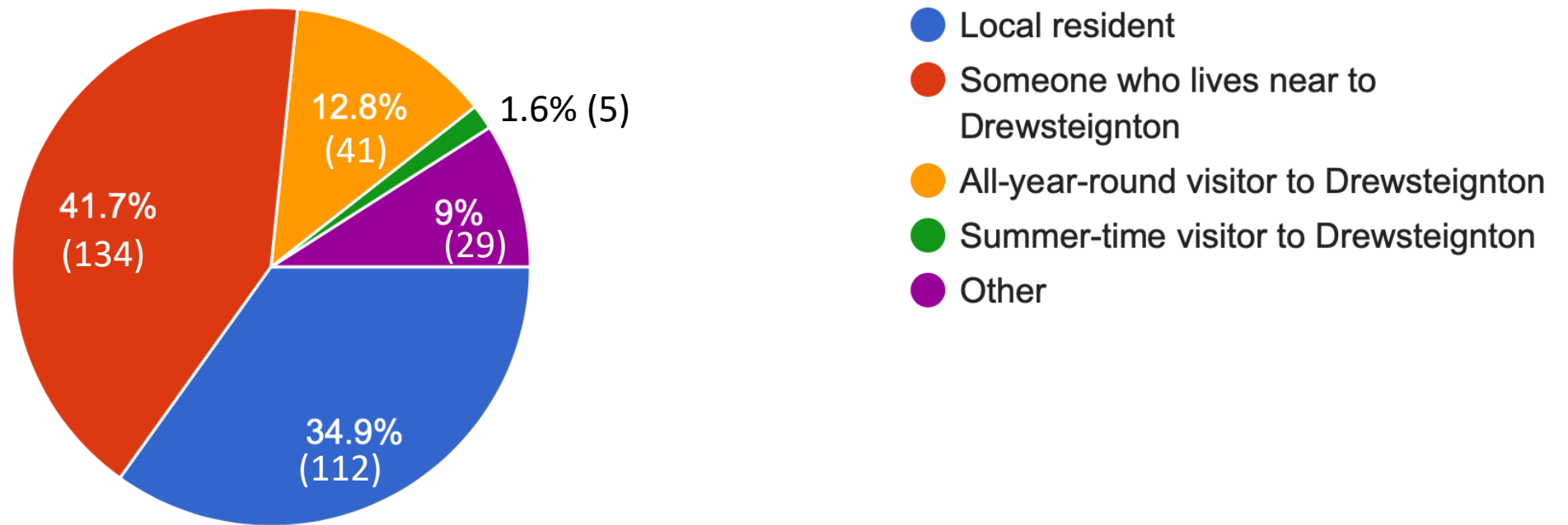

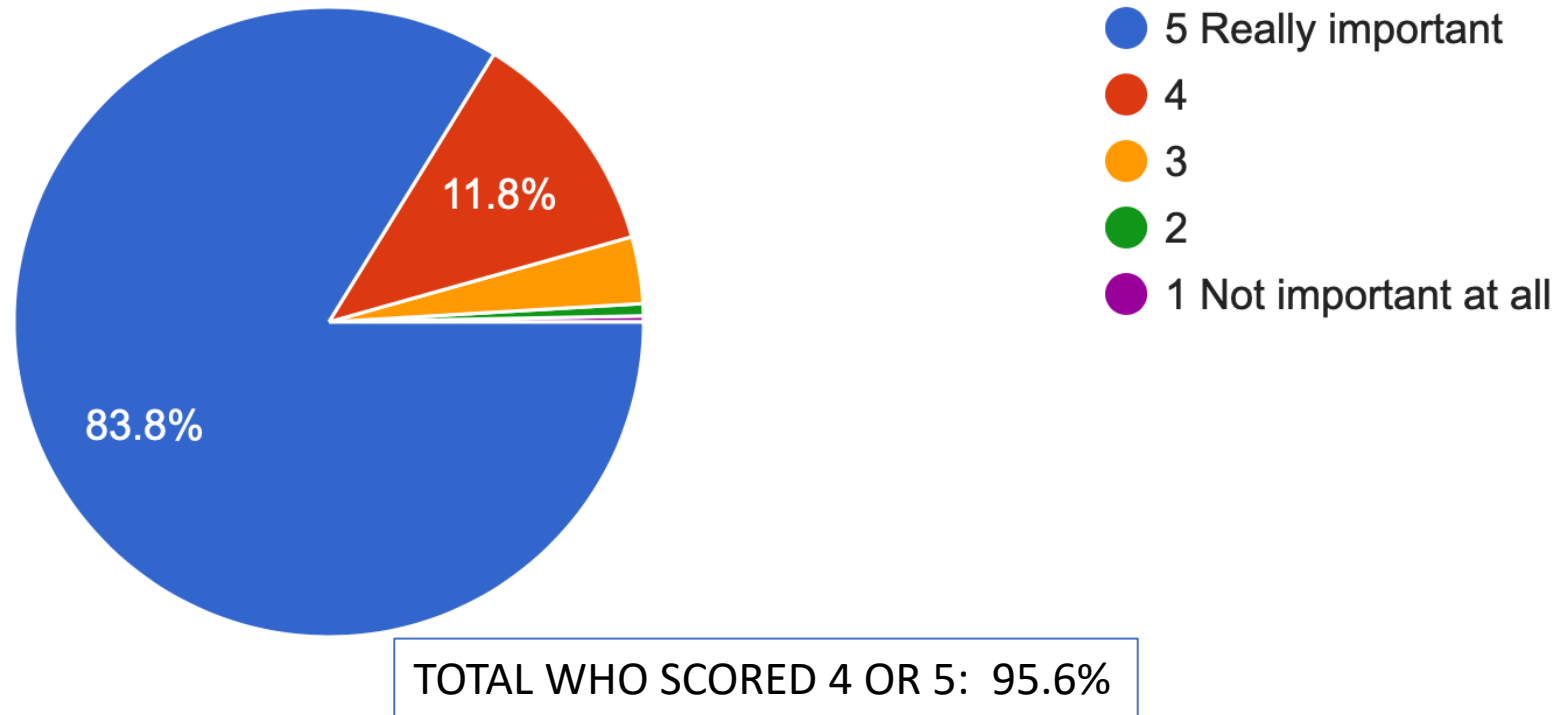

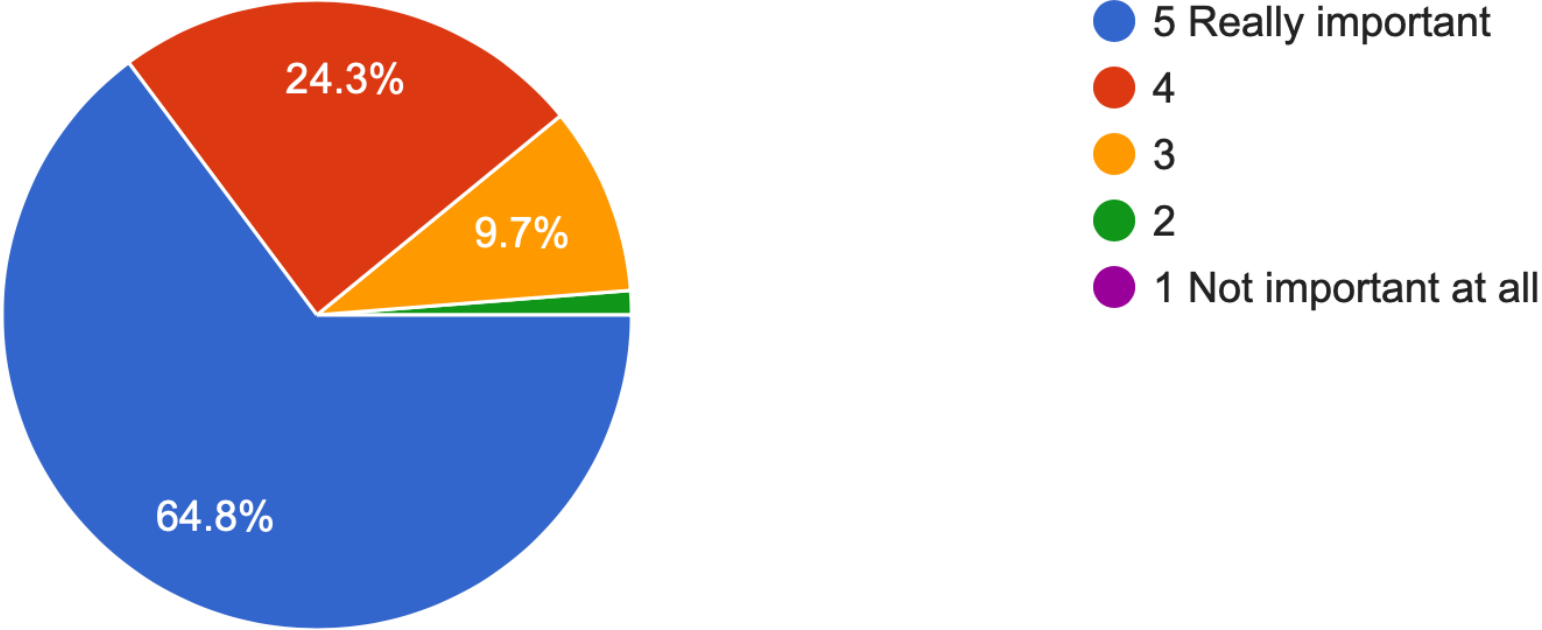

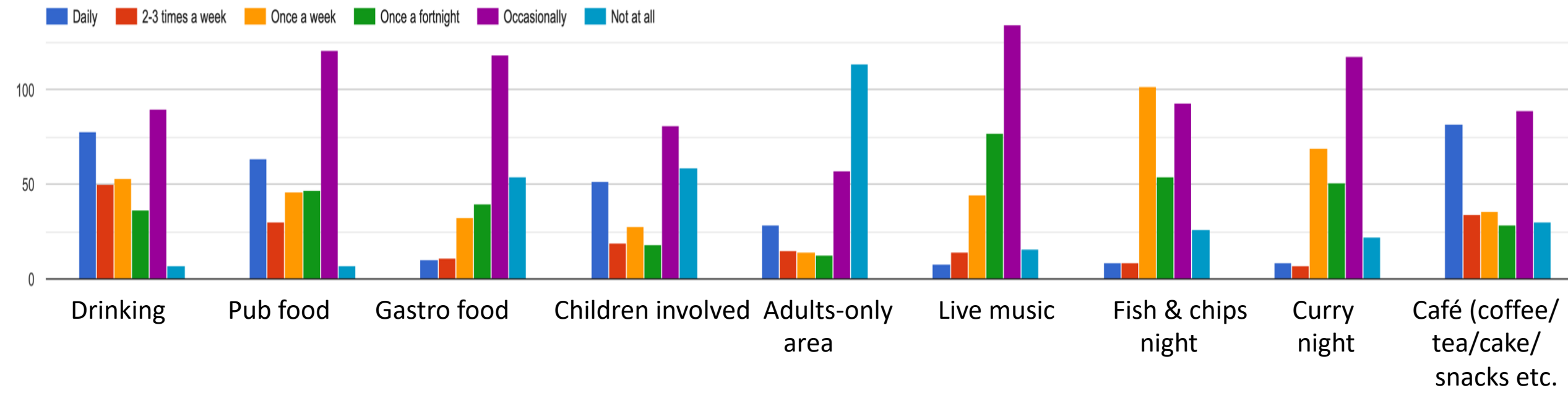

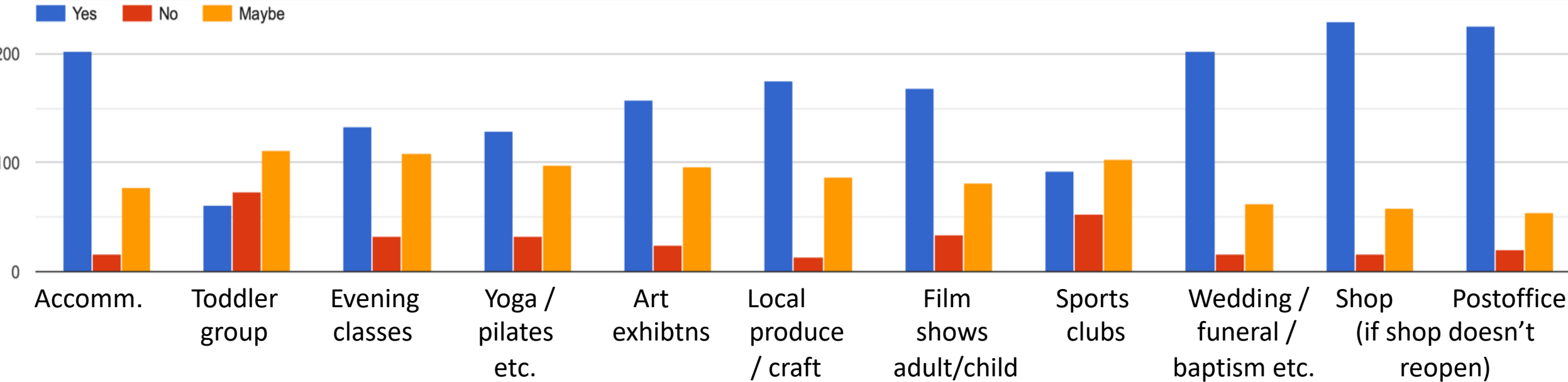

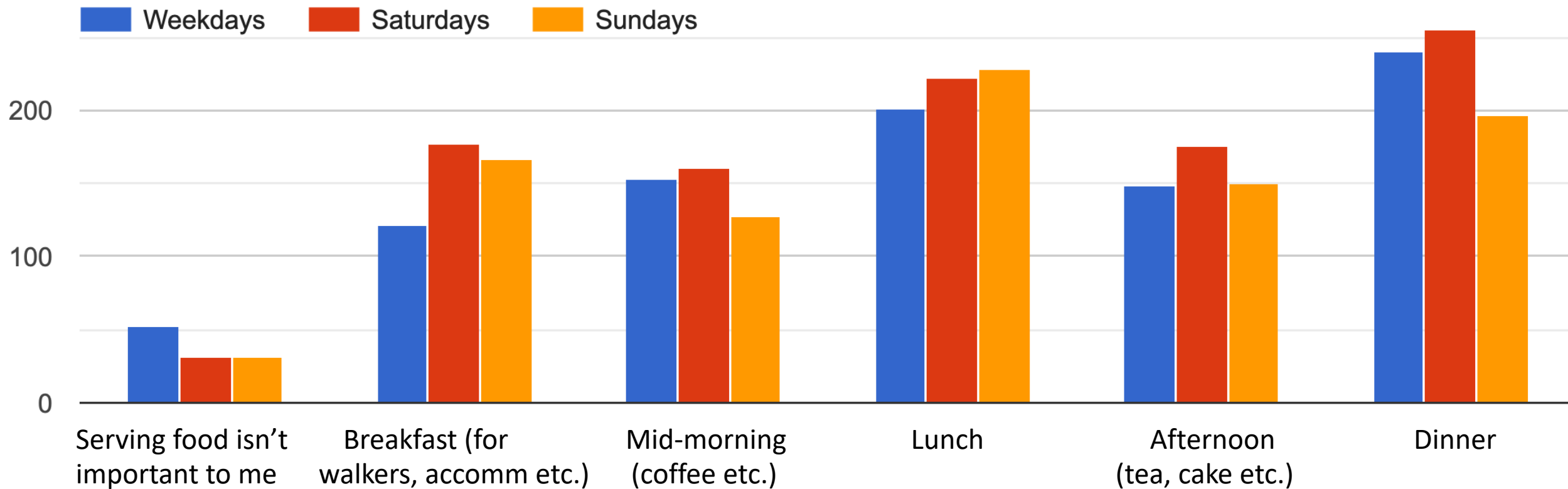

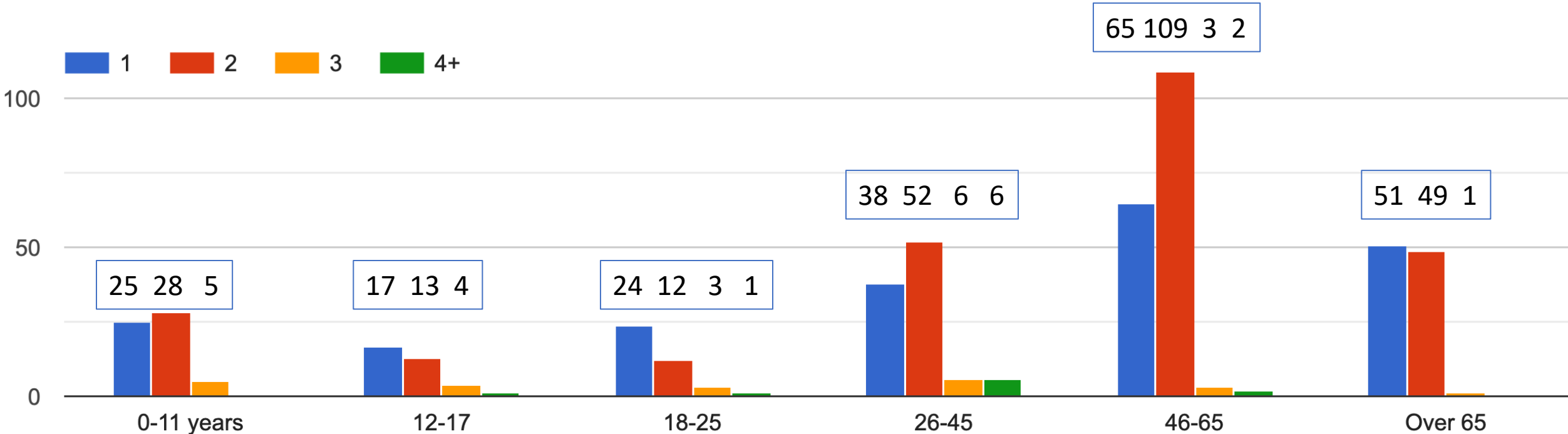
